

The Snooker Career of Steve Davis

- 1) Steve Davis was born on the 22nd August 1957
Before, starting at a young age, playing snooker was to take him to heaven
In the 1980's he was to gradually prove the best
Playing better than all the rest
- 2) In the 1980's Steve won 6 World Championships, 6 UK Championships
And 3 Masters Trophies yes
Was doing extremely very well or so I guess
For many different but good reasons
He was ranked number 1 for 7 consecutive seasons
- 3) In 1987/88 having won all 3 Championships playing in top gear
Steve received 'The BBC Sports Personality of The Year'
Also for playing so well watched by you and me
In 1988 he was awarded an MBE
- 4) It only looked like Steve could face the sack
When in the 1985 final, against Dennis Taylor
He missed the World Championship concluding black
In one of the most popular snooker matches watched on TV for ages
Which was to make all the different sports pages
- 5) Steve announced his snooker playing retirement on the 17th April 2016
Though as a TV Commentator he'll still regularly be seen
As a professional snooker player he's been such a special one
He was even given an OBE in 2001
