- 2) Wordsworth went to St John's College too Also, at the University of Oxford, and Cambridge, joined quite a few And he was to become an English Romantic poet With lots of different people to soon get to know it
- 3) In 1793 Wordsworth had his first poetry publication Which proved popular with no hesitation Then following a little bit of debate He published 'Lyrical Ballads' in 1798
- 4) In 1802 Wordsworth took Mary Hutchinson as his wife Who, with 5 children, managed to liven up his life And they each quite definitely Enjoyed listening to his all-round poetry
- 5) Wordsworth then became Poet Laureate in 1843
 Doing lots of writing still to be seen by you and me
 With him continuing so for a total of 7 successive years
 Until his death on the 23rd April 1850 brought some tears
